In 1918: The Sedition Act of 1918 was passed by the U.S. Congress, which made criticizing the government as an imprisonable offense.

In 1943: SS General Jürgen Stroop ordered the burning of the Warsaw Ghetto, ending a month of Jewish resistance. 13,000 Jews died, with about half burnt alive or suffocated.
