Red Ribbon Week takes place annually from October 23-31<sup>st</sup> and is the country's oldest and largest drug prevention initiative. It was created in 1985 after the death of Drug Enforcement Agent (DEA) Enrique "Kiki" Camarena, who was murdered by drug traffickers that he was investigating in Mexico. During this week, people wear ribbons to recognize the sacrifice of these agents and the thousands of people who lose their lives to substance misuse every year.
